Description of activities. Design and Technology	<p>This placement is suited to students with a technical background as well as design who would like experience assisting and providing input on activities for teaching in the Design and Technology department. Creating 3D structures with the use of different materials and with the possibility to incorporate electronics and IT. You should be skilled in technology, be proactive and enterprising.</p> <p>You would be able to get involved in the different projects and extra curricular clubs. For example: Primary and Secondary programming club, Robotics and Drones.</p> <p>You would assist in planning the different tasks to achieve the students objectives, project management, scheduling, and management of materials and resources.</p>

	<p>You would work alongside the partner teacher to train in skills such as 3D printing, design, programming, the use of semiprofessional audiovisual media, robotics and prototyping and modeling of products and ideas. Art, Sculpture, Technical drawing and Graphic Design.</p> <p>Intercultural strategies are used to promote a positive learning environment and encourage the pupil's international mindedness and you would be expected to demonstrate an understanding, patient, warm, and receptive attitude towards the pupils and show interest in their progress.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Placement Duration: 10 months (shorter placements may be considered) • Language required: English • Salary: Unpaid, however you will be provided with free accommodation in rented flats or in the campus residence.
